Guidelines for the preparation and submission of abstracts.

Theme: Occupational Safety and Health Sustainability, "Leveraging on Technology".

- 1. All abstracts MUST be relevant to the conference theme and aligned to one or more of the following conference subthemes.
- a. Climate change and OSH,
- b. The digital world of work,
- c. Human rights at work, and
- d. Mental Health at Work.
- e. Ergonomics
- f. Hazardous substances
- 2. All abstracts shall be written in English and must be a maximum 300 words in Times New Roman font size 12.
- 3. The abstract should include Title, Author's name(s) and contact address, email and telephone numbers, introduction, objective, methodology/methods, results/findings, conclusions and recommendations, if any and keywords.
- 4. The communication papers should highlight workplace success stories, experiences, best practices, and challenges in OSH practice.
- 5. The abstracts shall be reviewed by the abstract review committee whose decision shall be final.
- 6. All abstracts shall be treated with confidentiality and in accordance with the data protection laws.
