Guidelines for the preparation and submission of abstracts.

Theme: Occupational Safety and Health Sustainability, “Leveraging on Technology”.

1. All abstracts **MUST** be relevant to the conference theme and aligned to one or more of the following conference subthemes.
 - a. Climate change and OSH,
 - b. The digital world of work,
 - c. Human rights at work, and
 - d. Mental Health at Work.
 - e. Ergonomics
 - f. Hazardous substances
2. All abstracts shall be written in English and must be a maximum 300 words in Times New Roman font size 12.
3. The abstract should include Title, Author’s name(s) and contact address, email and telephone numbers, introduction, objective, methodology/methods, results/findings, conclusions and recommendations, if any and keywords.
4. The communication papers should highlight workplace success stories, experiences, best practices, and challenges in OSH practice.
5. The abstracts shall be reviewed by the abstract review committee whose decision shall be final.
6. All abstracts shall be treated with confidentiality and in accordance with the data protection laws.
