**DECLARATION OF JOB OPPORTUNITIES**

**A. BACKGROUND**

The Government of Kenya has been collaborating with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) in enhancing safe, regular, and productive labour migration between the two countries. Through this initiative thousands of Kenyans have been facilitated to secure employment opportunities in various economic sectors in the KSA. This includes twenty-seven (27) specialist nurses who were recruited in September 2023 to work in various government hospitals.

In furtherance of this collaboration, the State Department for Labour and Skills Development is pleased to announce a second recruitment drive for specialist nurses for employment through a Government to Government arrangement in the government hospitals in the KSA.

Interested and qualified Kenyans are invited to apply for the positions based on the criteria below.

**B. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. Be a Kenyan Citizen
2. Gender: Female
3. Hold a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing /Diploma of Nursing-Midwifery European Union (min 3 years post secondary school)
4. Be a registered and licensed member of the Nursing Council of Kenya, and in good standing.
4. Be in possession of a valid Police Clearance Certificate.
5. Work Experience: Handling patient care in hospital-based care e.g inpatient, ER, ICU.
6. Language — English proficiency in writing and speaking
7. Medically fit,
8. Hold a valid Kenyan passport
9. Age: less than 45 years old.

10. Prometric Test: Must have a valid Prometric Results; If not, the same can be taken either in Kenya OR KSA (Prometric test cost to be deducted from the employee's salary in 3 instalments)

11. Data Flow Verification: Dataflow verification report for the education certificate and Nursing Council License or latest employment certificate is mandatory.

### **C. BASIC TERMS**

- a) Period of Contract — One (1) year renewable,
- b) Salary: Minimum of 4,110.00 SAR basic salary plus an additional 295 SAR for each year of experience.
- c) Work hours — 8 hours/day
- d) Paid Annual vacation with free round trip economy ticket.
- e) Overtime — In accordance with the Saudi Arabia Labour Laws


