**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON PROPOSED NATIONAL POLICY
ON HIV AND AIDS AT WORK**

The Directorate of Occupational Safety and Health Services is in charge with the administration of the Occupational Safety and Health Act, OSHA 2007 and the Work Injury Benefits Act, WIBA 2007 to ensure the safety, health and welfare of all workers and to ensure equitable compensation of workers injured in the course of their employment and for connected purposes.

Pursuant to Section 23(3), 23(8) and 25 of the OSHA 2007, DOSHS in collaboration with the social partners has drafted the National HIV and AIDS at Work Policy. Currently, there are two separate policy documents on HIV and AIDS at Work; one for the public sector and another for FKE members. The draft National Policy incorporates these two, and goes further to give specific responsibilities to all key players.

This is to invite public participation of all stakeholders and members of the Public by submitting their views on the draft National Policy. The draft policy can be downloaded from www.labour.go.ke
